

INFORMATION ON THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

Pursuant to Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003, as amended (**'Privacy Code'**) and European Regulation no. 679 of 2016 (the **'Privacy Regulation'**), The Data Controller is Tecnosystemi S.p.A. Società Benefit (Tax Code and VAT No. 02535780247) with registered office in 31029 Vittorio Veneto (TV), Via dell'Industria 2/4, e-mail info@tecnosystemi.com, as Data Controller (hereinafter, the **'Data Controller'**), wishes to inform you that your personal data will be processed in order to manage your request to be contacted by the Data Controller.

Through the 'Contact request' and 'Request information' areas, you can describe your requests for information or needs, but we ask you not to provide data defined by the Privacy Regulation as special categories of data (e.g. relating to your health, religious orientation, etc.).

The legal basis for the processing is the performance of a service pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, letter b) of the Privacy Regulation and, therefore, no express consent on your part will be necessary in order to manage your request.

The data you provide will be processed mainly using paper and/or computerised means under the authority of the Data Controller by specifically designated, authorised and trained persons (pursuant to Articles 2-quaterdecies of the Privacy Code and 29 of the Privacy Regulation). We inform you that appropriate security measures are observed, also pursuant to Articles 5 and 32 of the Privacy Regulation, to prevent data loss, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorised access.

The data may be communicated, within the EU, in full compliance with the provisions of the Privacy Regulation, to the following subjects: to public bodies and/or authorities, where required by law or at their request; to external structures, entities and companies used by the Data Controller to carry out activities connected with, instrumental to or consequential to the performance of the "Contact request" and "Request information" services; to external consultants, even when not designated in writing as Data Processors.

The updated list of designated Data Processors can be provided upon request by interested parties to the Data Controller's email address.

Without prejudice to legal obligations and judicial protection, your personal data will be stored for a period not exceeding 6 months.

Articles 15 et seq. of the Privacy Regulation grant the data subject the right to obtain, in the manner and within the limits established by Article 2-undecies of the Privacy Code and Article 12 of the Privacy Regulation:

- confirmation of the existence or otherwise of personal data concerning you, even if not yet recorded, and its communication in intelligible form;

- indication of the origin of the personal data, the purposes and methods of processing, the logic applied in the case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments, and the identification details of the data controller;
- the updating, rectification, integration, erasure, anonymisation or blocking of data processed unlawfully – including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which it was collected or subsequently processed – certification that these operations have been brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of those to whom the data has been communicated or disseminated, except where this proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared to the right being protected.

The data subject also has the right:

- to withdraw consent (where given) to the processing of personal data at any time (without prejudice to the lawfulness of processing based on consent given prior to withdrawal);
- to object, in whole or in part, on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even if pertinent to the purpose of collection;
- to object, in whole or in part, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her for the purpose of sending advertising or direct sales material or for carrying out market research or commercial communication;
- to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority in the cases provided for by the Privacy Regulation, by contacting the Data Protection Authority directly: Website www.garanteprivacy.it Email: protocollo@gpdp.it Switchboard: (+39) 06.69677.1;
- to the portability of personal data within the limits set out in Article 20 of the Privacy Regulation.
