









PRIVACY POLICY

Pursuant to European Regulation no. 679 of 2016 (the "Privacy Regulation"), Tecnosystemi SpA. Benefit Company intends to inform you and all users and/or visitors of the www.tecnosystemi.com site (the "Users" and the "Site" respectively), regarding the use of personal data collected through the Site itself.

1.Data controller and managers

2. Information collected automatically by the Site

Like all websites, our Site also uses log files, in which information collected automatically during your visits is stored. In fact, the computer systems and software procedures used to operate the Website automatically acquire some information during use, the transmission of which is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

The information collected is as follows:

- internet Protocol (IP) address or domain name of the device you use;
- browser type and device parameters used to connect to the Site;
- the addresses in Uniform Resource Identifier (URI) notation of the requested resources, or the method used in submitting the request to the server;
- internet service provider (ISP) name;
- date and time of visit;
- web page of origin (referral) and exit of the User;
- possibly the number of clicks;
- the size of the file obtained in response:
- the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error,
- other parameters relating to the operating system and the IT environment of your device.

This information is processed in an automated form and collected exclusively in aggregate form in order to verify the correct functioning of the Site.



























3. The personal data you provide to us using the Site: for what purpose we process them We use your data to allow you to:

- access the Site and browse it;
- access the services offered therein (e.g. contacts, newsletters, etc.) as requested by you.

Your data is processed for the following purposes:

- (i) to fulfil legal obligations;
- (ii) carry out the technical management of the Site;

The data provided by you will be processed mainly with IT tools under the authority of the Data Controller, by subjects specifically appointed, designated and instructed in the processing, pursuant to articles 29 of the Privacy Regulation and 2 quaterdecies of the Privacy Code. We inform you that suitable security measures are also observed pursuant to articles 5 and 32 of the Privacy Regulation to prevent data loss, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorized access.

4. Nature of the provision of data and legal basis of the processing

With reference to the purposes referred to in Art. 3, point (iii), reference should be made to what is expressly indicated in the specific information referred to in this Privacy Policy.

For the purposes referred to in points (i) and (ii) of the previous art. 3, the provision of your personal data is necessary as otherwise you will not be able to use the services offered by the Site. Consequently, for the purposes referred to in point (i) the legal basis of the processing is the fulfillment of legal obligations, pursuant to art. 6 paragraph 1, letter (c) of the Privacy Regulation, while for the purposes referred to in point (ii) the legal basis of the processing is the execution of the services provided through the Site and requested by you, pursuant to article 6, paragraph 1, letter. (b) of the Privacy Regulation.

Further details regarding the foregoing are contained in the specific information reported or displayed on the Site and prepared for the relevant services on request.

5. To whom and in what context can we transmit your data

Your data may be communicated, within the EU, to external structures, subjects and companies (including consultants and service providers) that the Data Controller uses for the management of the Site and for carrying out activities connected, instrumental or consequent to the execution of the services offered by the Site.

6. Your rights
